ACC (Lagoon water maintenance firm) MANAGEMENT REPORT: Crew successfully cleaned up all widgeon grass, which has not returned. Results from Green Bull to eliminate coliform are encouraging. It appears that the beneficial microorganisms are outperforming the coliform bacteria. More results in September.

PUBLIC WORKS: NA, report next month. The City has no appropriate linkage to the lagoon website.

TREASURER'S REPORT: CDs matured, new ones invested.
